
World Hemispheres




Western Hemisphere

The part of the earth that lies to the west of an imaginary line, is known as the Western Hemisphere. It includes the Americas, Greenland, Caribbean Islands, and half of Antarctica.



Eastern Hemisphere

The part of the earth that lies to the east of an imaginary line, is known as the Eastern Hemisphere. It includes Africa, Europe, Asia and Australia.



Northern Hemisphere

The part of the earth that lies to the north of an imaginary line, is known as the Northern Hemisphere. It includes all of the land and water that is between the equator and the North Pole.



Southern Hemisphere

The part of the earth that lies to the south of an imaginary line, is known as the Southern Hemisphere. It includes all of the land and water that is between the equator and the South Pole
